## **OVARIAN CANCER RESEARCH FUNDING OPPORTUNITY**

Preproposals: Due by June 5, 2007

Proposals : Due by August 9, 2007

The Fiscal Year 2007 (FY07) Ovarian Cancer Research Program (OCRP) is offering the HBCU/MI FELLOWSHIP AWARD to SUPPORT a MENTORED TRAINING and RESEARCH experience for HBCU/MI doctoral-level faculty members who aim to develop a productive career in ovarian cancer research. One key element of this award is the involvement of a designated mentor who has an established research program in ovarian cancer and who will guide the HBCU/MI faculty member in the development of the training plan and a research project in ovarian cancer for the proposed fellowship. The training plan should provide for acquisition of any needed skills, including laboratory and clinical techniques and grant-writing skills. These can be acquired through collaboration with the mentor and/or attendance at courses, workshops, and scientific meetings. The research plan should enable the HBCU/MI faculty member to collect and analyze sufficient preliminary data to write an ovarian cancer research proposal, either as the lead investigator or as a collaborator. It is expected that the research will be performed at the mentor's institution. No preliminary data are required for submission to this award.

Funding can be requested for a maximum of \$300,000 for direct costs over a 3-year performance period, plus indirect costs as appropriate.
