The 2007-08 Resource Center for Science and Engineering Fellowship Competition

The Resource Center for Science and Engineering is announcing its Fellowship Competition for academic year 2007-2008, for the following projects: the Alliance for Graduate Education for the Professoriate (AGEP), the NSF-EPSCoR, and the Puerto Rico NASA Space Grant (PR-NSG) Program.

The objective of AGEP is to increase enrollment of minority students in doctoral programs in Chemistry, Chemical Physics, Biology, Mathematics, Civil Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Marine Sciences and Computational Sciences and Engineering.

This year, NSF-EPSCoR doctoral fellowships will be awarded only in the area of nanotechnology, in order to increase the number of graduates in this research area, thus making a significant contribution to the diversity of the nanotechnology workforce.

The PR-NASA Space Grant Program will award doctoral, master and undergraduate fellowships to increase the number of Puerto Rican students enrolled in research areas of interest to NASA.

The application deadline is Friday, April 27, 2007.
